Transportation: The church bus will be driven to camp. An extra car will follow the bus for any emergencies.

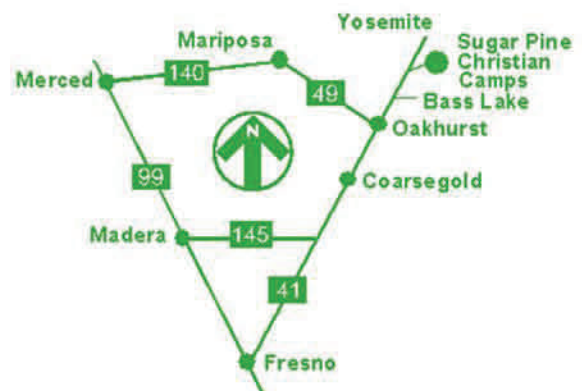
Camp Departure to Fremont Info: We leave camp at **1:00 PM** on **Sunday, February 26** and arrive at the church between 5-5:30 PM.
