1. Describe a time in your life when you were confronted with an opportunity to share God's plan of redemption in a hostile situation. How did your faith give you strength to endure it?

Read Daniel 4:1-27

2. Daniel was considered the best person in his workplace/family but treated as the last option to contribute. How would you react if you were in his position?
3. How would you prepare yourself if you feel deeply convinced and convicted in your heart to confront a friend, a brother, or your boss of wrongdoing?
4. Why do you think Daniel focused his emphasis on the testimony of Nebuchadnezzar about the following truths of the Word of God, which are repeated several times in the chapter?
 - God ruling in the kingdom of men
 - God's kingdom is everlasting
 - His dominion endures from generation to generation
5. What is the significance of the Holy Spirit (NKJV) in the understanding of the king in relationship to his problem?
6. It seems verses 1-3 demonstrate a big change in Nebuchadnezzar's attitude compared to the temperament he showed in verses 5-7. What experience do you think causes this change?
